Topic

Language, Mathematics and Health and Well-Being

This term in Language, pupils will continue to develop skills through the active literacy program. Phonological skills and strategies will continue to be a strong emphasis to consolidate spelling rules they have learnt.

Comprehension skills will continue to be developed from their reading groups as well as whole class novel activities. Pupils in Primary 4 will also start accelerated reading.

Pupils will complete various writing tasks such as information reports, imaginative story writing, functional writing such as letters, invitations and menu's.

Higher standards of VCOP (vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuations) will be expected in their writing at this stage of their learning.

In Mathematics pupils will continue to build on their knowledge of number processes as well as learning about time.

In Health and Wellbeing pupils will continue to explore children's rights as stated by the UN conventions of the Right of a Child. Pupils will also expand their knowledge about substance misuse.

Science, Technology and Social Subjects

In Science, pupils will investigate forces and work on a project with magnets.

Social Studies will link with the terms topic of the Vikings.

In ICT pupils will learn more about internet safety and how to use a PowerPoint presentation.

Expressive Arts and RME
