Language, Mathematics and Health and Well-Being

They will also develop their skills in recording information. In Health & Wellbeing pupils will investigate how the media affects what we purchase and how to prevent diseases and infections. They will continue to explore children's rights as stated by the UN conventions of the Right of a Child."
