Homework

Topic

This term Primary 7 will be finishing off our World War Two topic. We will also be starting a mini topic – Natural Disasters. This will develop their skills in science, research and investigating the impact of natural disasters on people and the landscape.

Language, Mathematics and Health and Well-Being



Writing this term will include report writing, poetry and persuasive writing and much of it will be based around our topic

of Natural Disasters. Reading will be similar to last term as we will be following the Active Literacy scheme.

The class have been split into ability groups to work on a class reader – developing those strategies learned during the modelled sessions in term 1.



Maths this term will be Whole Number and Fractions. One day a week the children will work on Information Handling with Mrs Jack.

This term, in Health and Wellbeing we will be focusing on healthy food choices and in P.E we will be working on fitness/athletics and hockey.

Technology and Social Subjects

Technology will be taught through ICT in the curriculum and through activities linked with the topic of Natural Disasters. Social subjects will be taught largely through the class topic.
