Homework

This term Primary 7 will receive homework on a Monday which is to be handed in on a Friday. Homework this term will be spelling and maths. Children will also be expected to complete a speed test for various aspects of maths work to develop their speed during mental maths activities. Their score will be recorded each week.

Investigators homework will be given every two weeks. This is an investigative exercise in which they are expected to learn from. Pupils must research about the given topic which they have a say in, and present their information in an attractive way in a double page spread.

Topic

Our term 4 topic is Australia. We will be learning about the different types of habitats and wildlife in Australia as well as the diversity of cultures and customs including the Aborigines. This is a great topic with lots of great learning opportunities.



Language, Mathematics and Health and Well-Being

Writing this term will include poetry, functional, diary and imaginative writing. The majority of it will be based around our topic of Australia. Reading and spelling will be similar to last term as we will be following the Active Literacy scheme.

The class have been split into ability groups to work on a class reader – developing those strategies learned during the modelled sessions in term 1, 2 and 3.



Maths this term will be Algebra, Shape and Information Handling. The children will be working on Measure with Mrs Reynolds.

In Health and Wellbeing we will be focusing on relationships. In P.E we will be learning about athletics, skipping and netball.

Technology and Social Subjects

Technology will be taught through ICT in the curriculum and through activities linked with our topic. Social subjects will be taught largely through the class topic Australia.

Expressive Arts and RME

Art will be taught by Mrs Campbell and Music this term will be taught through activities linked to topic.

RME will have a focus on the Aboriginal Dream Time stories and beliefs.
