




Welcome

Targets

The targets are ongoing each week when your child achieves their target we would like you to discuss your child's target with them and help them to choose a new one. New boys and girls will get introduced to target cards soon. (Your child's key-worker will explain what to do) Well done to everyone for their hard work on their target cards already.

We will be starting "Question of the day" this is to develop the children's writing skills as they will write their own name each day while using the signing in board. We will be concentrating on pencil hold and control.
