Children will also be expected to complete a speed test for various aspects of maths work to develop their speed during mental maths activities. Their score will be recorded each week.

Topic

Our term 3 topic is Biological Systems. We will be learning about the different systems that keep our bodies alive including: the digestive system, the respiratory system, circulatory system and the brain.

Language, Mathematics and Health and Well-Being



Writing this term will include poetry, persuasive writing and functional writing. The majority of it will be based around our topic of Biological

Systems. Reading and spelling will be similar to last term as we will be following the Active Literacy scheme.

The class have been split into ability groups to work on a class reader – developing those strategies learned during the modelled sessions in term 1 and 2.



Maths this term will be Fractions, Decimals and Percentages and Algebra. One day a week the children will work on Information Handling with Mrs Reynolds.

In Health and Wellbeing we will be focusing on Drugs and Alcohol with Mrs Buchan. In P.E we will be learning how to play tag rugby.

Technology and Social Subjects

Technology will be taught through ICT in the curriculum and through activities linked with the topic of Biological Systems. Social subjects will be taught largely through the class topic.

Art and Music this term will be taught through activities linked to topic.
