Snow Closures

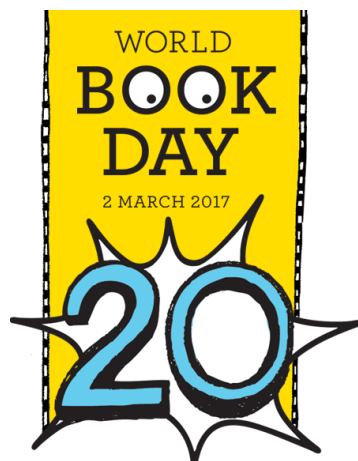
As winter approaches, please remember the procedure for finding out if Rosehearty School is closed. There are 2 main ways – the School information line for snow closures, etc:
