Homework



Every **Monday**, pupils will be issued phonics and spelling homework, some weeks there will be Maths homework. This should be completed and returned on the **Friday** of that week. Homework each week will be indicated on the homework note. Children may also have additional activities related to what they have been learning in class.

Topic

Our Five Senses



Primary 1 will be studying '**Senses and Myself**' as their topic this term.

The children will be learning about our 5 senses, how they are used and why we need them. They will also be learning about themselves - the physical body, where they will learn the names of body parts and essential organs etc - and the emotional side, where they will learn to understand feelings and why they may feel a certain way at certain times.

Language, Mathematics and Health and Well-Being

Children will be learning their **phonics** sounds twice a week - Monday and Thursday for the introduction of the new sounds. They will be practising them in class, but help at home with homework is extremely beneficial for your child, and greatly appreciated!

Spelling will also be done in class for the core practice, but help by going over the common words from their tub every night, and in remembering the order of letters in words, is greatly appreciated.

Writing this term will be stimulated by stories we have read in class, children's personal experiences, or stem from aspects of our topic.



Reading this term will be done in class from big books, and be teacher led. It will be followed up with comprehension activities which will link to prior learning, and develop skills such as prediction and recall.



Although children don't have reading books home this term, we encourage you to read to/with your child as much as possible to develop their vocabulary, and love of reading.

Maths this term will begin with whole number knowledge where the children will be gaining a

fuller understand of the concepts of numbers to 10, and what they represent. We will also look at some aspects of information handling later this term.

For **Health and Wellbeing**, Primary 1 will be covering aspects of this through our topic work. We will also be discussing how to be a good friend, and sharing etc.



Science, Technology and Social Subjects

Primary 1 will cover **science** related outcomes through our topic of senses when we are investigating how they work.

We will cover **social studies** outcomes as part of the topic as we understand 'Myself'. The children will be talking about where they live and maybe learning out about the world of work.



Your child will be using **technology** within the classroom i.e. the SMARTboard to play interactive games on, and to watch learning clips, videos and songs on. Your child will be developing skills with the ICT specialist during ICT time.

Expressive Arts and RME

Art this term will be based around our topic and calendar of school events i.e. McMillan Coffee morning.

RME this term will focus on Christian stories and beliefs, and the understanding of fairness and sharing.

Home Time

Please make sure there is an adult there for your child when going home. If for any reason the usual arrangement for your child going home changes, please make the school aware by a phonecall, or a note in the home-school book.



Also, if your child is a bus pupil and isn't using the transport for a specific reason i.e. going to a friends to play, hospital appointment etc; then please make sure the **bus driver AND the school** are made aware! Thank you!
