
Timetable

Language, Mathematics and Health and Well-Being

This term in Language pupils will be focusing on improving their handwriting and spelling using Active Literacy. They will develop their skills in functional and imaginative writing using the Big Writing Programme of work. Children will be more involved in supporting each other and editing each other's work.



In Maths pupils will continue to build on their knowledge of number processes and shape.

In Health & Wellbeing we will investigate mental and emotional wellbeing and explore coping strategies. In P.E they will develop

skills in playing team games and athletics.

Science, Technology and Social Subjects

In Science Primary 3 will investigate the materials used to construct buildings with and create items found in the home. They will also explore simple electrical circuits. They will develop their skills in Technology by creating a building with junk and have ICT with Mrs Grant.

In Social Studies they will investigate their local area and compare buildings in different countries.

Expressive Arts and RME

Primary 3 will have Art lessons on Thursday and I would suggest you provide an art apron or old shirt to protect new school uniforms. i-pad Music lessons this term will be covered by Mr Watt. Drama with Mrs Potts will be on Thursday. In RME they will be focusing on Christianity and Bible stories.
