Topic

Our topic for term 1 will be Endangered Species. Throughout the term we will be learning about their habitats, the dangers they face and what we can do to prevent this in the future.

Language, Mathematics and Health and Well-Being

This term in Language, pupils will continue to develop skills through the active literacy program. Phonological skills and strategies will continue to be a strong emphasis to consolidate spelling rules they have learnt.

Comprehension skills will continue to be developed from their reading

groups as well as whole class novel activities.

Pupils will also complete various writing tasks such as information reports, imaginative story writing, and functional writing such as letters, invitations and menus.

Higher standards of VCOP (vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuations) will be expected in their writing at this stage of their learning.

In Mathematics pupils will continue to build on their knowledge of addition and subtraction as well as learning about measure.

In Health and Wellbeing pupils will be focusing on positive relationships which will be covered by our visiting specialist teacher Mrs Buchan.

Science, Technology and Social Subjects

Social Studies will link with the term's topic, Endangered Species.
