Play number recognition games and look for numbers around the house.  Practise number bonds 10-20  Talk to your child about halving objects, e.g., toast or fruit and vegetables.  Allow your child to read the time, pointing out the hour and minute hand..  Practise the days and seasons of the year.  Practise using a calendar to plan events. <p><b>Phonics-</b> I can recognise phonemes and form simple 3 letter words.  <b>Common words-</b> I can recognise and write common words.  <b>Writing-</b> I can try to write common words independently.  I can sound out and write words in my story.  I can use a capital letter at the start of a sentence.  I can use a full stop at the end of a sentence.  I can attempt to write a sentence independently.  <b>Reading-</b> I can sound out new words.  I can hear syllables and rhyming words.  I can talk about characters and predict what happens next.  I can use expression when I read.</p>	<p>Log into Google Classroom each Monday afternoon to access new sounds and common words. Practise using the activities given. Interact with Education City activities that will benefit learning. Encourage them to write and draw using different materials. Give them the opportunity to develop their pencil control. Help them to write their name using the correct upper- and lower-case letters.
