| <p>Numeracy- I can round numbers to the nearest 10.</p> <p>Addition/Subtraction – I can add and subtract numbers 2 digit numbers.</p> <p>Multiplication – I can make array patterns to show multiplication.</p> <p>Fractions – I can split a whole object into equally sized parts. I can share out a group of items. I can use symmetry to partition groups into two, four and eight parts.</p> <p>Time - I can tell the time using 12 hour notation. I can show the o'clock time on an analogue clock. I can say the names of the months and how many days in a year.</p> <p>Movement- I can follow verbal directions for a route eg half turn, forward</p> | <p>Complete activities and interact on Education City.</p> <p>Play number recognition games and look for numbers around the house.</p> <p>Practise number bonds to 20.</p> <p>Talk to your child about fractions – half or quarter of toast, fruit, or vegetables.</p> <p>Allow your child to read the time.</p> <p>Practise the days, months, and seasons of the year.</p> <p>Practise using a calendar to plan events.</p> <p>Play games where they follow directions eg forward 2 steps, quarter turn to the right Teaching Clock (topmarks.co.uk)</p> |

| <p>Common words- I can recognise and write common words.</p> <p>Writing- I can complete different writing tasks. I can begin sentences with a capital letter and end with a full stop. I can use descriptive words and connectives in sentences.</p> <p>Reading- I can use strategies to decode unfamiliar words. I can begin to use expression when reading. I can use pictures to support understanding. I can answer questions about a text.</p> | <p>Log into Google Classroom each Monday afternoon to access new sounds and common words. Practise using the activities given. Interact with Education City activities that will benefit learning. Encourage them to write and draw using different materials.
